





Military Leaders




- **George Henry Thomas**




- **Frederick Douglass**

- **Sojourner Truth**


A former slave and abolitionist, Truth gave powerful speeches that challenged racism and sexism and advocated for women's rights.


▪ Anna Ella Carroll

- **Sally Louisa Young**


A Confederate woman who served as a spy and courier for the Army of Northern Virginia, Young provided valuable information that helped shape the course of the war.

African Americans




- **Martin Robison Delany**

- **John Mercer Langston**


A lawyer, educator, and politician, Langston was one of the first African Americans elected to public office after the Civil War.


